STORMWATER DISCHARGE COMPLIANCE URBAN RUNOFF INFORMATION

City of Carson

The City of Carson is required under State law Senate Bill 205 and regulations to identify the potential effect that each business may have on water quality. All businesses are required to comply with the City of Carson Storm Water And Urban Runoff Pollution Control Regulations (City Code Chapter 8), which prohibits the discharge of pollutants and non-storm water to City streets and storm drains. Water that flows on streets and into storm drains is released to the nearest body of water, without treatment. Typical urban runoff pollutants include oils, chemicals, building materials, dirt, vegetative waste, and trash. All Carson based commercial businesses must complete and submit this form with a new business license application or annual renewal. Failure to submit this form will delay the issuance of the City tax certificate/business license.
